MINUTES OF MEETING HELD VIRTUALLY AT 7PM ON WEDNESDAY 19 JULY 2021

1. Attendance and apologies

Present: Cllr Marie Hartley (Chair), Nigel Coe, Ben Utting (Cricket Club) and S. Kent (Parish Clerk)

2. Declarations of Interest

Marie Hartley declared an interest as a member of Winterton Cricket Club.

3. Minutes of the Previous Meeting

The minutes of the meeting held on 10 February 2021 were agreed and will be signed by the Chairman at a later date.

4. Local Group Updates

Ben Utting (CC) gave a brief update where there is six weeks left of the season with two Saturday teams. ECB changed their guidance so refreshments have not been offered. Changing room shave been open for the opposition. Changing rooms are allowed to be open but ECB advice is also followed. Some ladies' games have been postponed. Under 9's still has games to play.

34 children have been seen to attend a training night with large numbers coming from the local area. A bid submitted by the CC has been received of £1000 for youth equipment. Cllr Hartley added how the newsletter was a positive representation of the club and local sport in general.

5. Playing Field Toilet and Changing Room Facilities

Ben shared how the middle of the structure has required some structural repairs which has had a temporary fix. Toilet cleaning has increased in light of the covid which a volunteer has kindly undertaken. Cllr Hartley raised the intention of working more closely with other clubs and organisation to work with identified 'key partners' however this would not hold the project moving forwards. Cllr Harley raised the question of replacement facilities for more people to use. Engagement event will be planned from September onwards.

Cllr Hartley and the **Clerk** are working on a specification which will give 'value of money' for a 'like for like' and achievable replacement with costs identified by potential external funding. This will be shared with the group and wider public before going out to tender. Health and well-being will be a priority and provision of facilities for the whole village is key.
